



VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTION

SERVING CREW (SMART SERVE REQUIRED)

Objective:

The Serving Crew will be responsible for serving both alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages to visitors while safely following Ontario regulations.

Responsibilities:

- Selling tickets for beverages
- Pouring and serving drinks in the drink tent.
- Following Smart Serve Laws and ensuring alcohol is only provided to those of age to consume and no one is over served.
- Set-up clean up and area as required.

Qualifications:

- Smart Serve Certification is required (numbers must be provided in advance)
- Leadership skills.
- Prior event experience an asset.

Time Commitment:

- Minimum one 3-4-hour shift (available shifts: Saturday, August 13th 10:30am-1:30pm; 1:30pm-4:30pm; 4:30pm-7:30pm; 7:30-11:30pm or Sunday, August 14th 10:30am-1:30pm; 1:30pm-4:30pm; 4:30pm-7:30pm) Must arrive 15 minutes before shift starts.

Dress:

- Volunteers will be provided with a volunteer shirt, which you must wear at all times during your volunteer shift. Please wear clothing that is comfortable and practical for your position, but not distracting or offensive to others. Event is rain or shine so please dress according to weather.
